2024 Focus

AGORADA 2024 will continue EURADA's current efforts to better understand the landscape of European regional development agencies by presenting the first preliminary results of the survey conducted jointly with the OECD and launched at the end of 2023 and by discussing the specific role and activities of national associations of development agencies in different national contexts. In addition, this year's edition will focus on impact investing and ensuring equal opportunities, both of which are pivotal topics to the work of regional development agencies. We will also highlight the ongoing and the future collaboration between European and Ukrainian regional development agencies within the framework of the UCORD project.

Furthermore, participants will be presented with the latest updates from the Partnerships for Regional Innovation (PRI) initiative and the S3 Community of Practice.

The festive highlight of AGORADA 2024 will be the presentation of the 2023 EURADA Awards, where three outstanding examples of regional development will be honoured by the members of the Jury from the European Committee of the Regions (CoR), the European Commission's Joint Research Centre (JRC) and the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD).
